



WICK HISTORY DETECTIVES: EDUCATION PACK

A LOCAL HISTORY STUDY RESOURCE USING OLD MAPS AND THE CENSUS FROM 1911

This pack includes all the resources you need to undertake a History Study of the village of Wick.

An interactive PowerPoint introducing several historic maps. Old photographs of cottages/houses from around 1900 and support information and resources for your students to undertake a local history study of the village of Wick.

Session One The PowerPoint looks at historic maps, the Victorian school and the schoolchildren with questions and discussion and supporting question sheet if needed. Then the CENSUS of 1911 is introduced and explained.

Session Two continues with PowerPoint and introduces all the cottages and houses asking interesting and relevant question for the students to answer or discuss. Then in pairs, students can follow this by opening an individual computer file of a House Folder to study. Each House Folder contains a photo of a house, copies of the 1911 Census and a Transcription. There are 20 different house folders for the whole class to study and enjoy.

Or if your school is in our local area, we can provide the teacher with 20 physical files containing the same laminated information.

We can also supply magnifying glasses and school slates and chalk to support the student history detectives in their study.

If you would prefer, we might be able to deliver the sessions for you, dressed as Edwardian ladies - and we also have a box of early 20th century artefacts and toys to bring with us.
